## **INSTALLATION OF NAL TEMPORARY FOUNDATIONS**

- 1. Position temporary foundation on a level and stable surface.
- 2. Remove pedestrian cover and side chamber lid on Retention Socket.
- 3. Connect duct to one of the duct entry points.
- 3. Attach appropriate lifting/moving equipment to existing traffic signal pole.
- 4. Cut existing traffic signal pole close to ground level.
- 5. Pull new cable through one of the duct entry points and up through retention socket head.
- 6. Position pole close to temporary foundation and joint cables together.
- 7. Lift pole into Retention socket ensuring the cable is pulled back through the duct entry point. The pole will sit on a ledge near to ground level once lowered.
- 8. Rotate pole into correct alignment and tighten 2no 24mm setscrews in retention socket.
- 9. Place round pedestrian plug inside the side chamber of socket and close rectangular side chamber cover.



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
